This DVD purchased by myself and was sent to me from a store in Japan.
Unfortunately, I found that, in order to play this legally-purchased DVD in
Linux, I would be forced to violate the DMCA twice.
First, I'd need to modify my DVD drive (by means of a firmware upgrade) to
allow it to play DVDs purchased anywhere in the world. Next, I'd need to play
it in a Linux media player called "Ogle", which uses illegal encryption-
defeating code to descramble and display DVDs.
Normally, playing DVDs purchased in the United States with a Linux media
player only requires one to violate the DMCA once.
