Upon buying most of the Bloodfist Collection (8 DVD), I found that I was
unable to watch my DVDs on my Windows PC because of the fact that my video
card (Geforce 3) has a TV out connection. Since I don't own any other DVD
player, the only way to view the DVDs is to de-encrypt the entire DVD to my
hard drive. Not only does this option require 3-4GB of hard drive space, but
the DMCA makes it illegal for me to view the movies I legally bought in this
manner. I am also unable to return the DVDs.
