I am an end user, operating Apple iPhones and iPads. As part of my work, I frequently need to set up Wifi networks in unfamiliar places. Apple does not allow WiFi scanning apps into their App Store. The app WiFiFoFum allows me to pull out my phone and see what other WiFi access points are operating in the area and what channels they are using, so that I can choose a less-crowded channel for mine.

The jailbreak community's response time to security threats is faster than Apple's. When a major PDF security flaw was located in iOS last year, Cydia had a patch posted in hours.
