

broadcast station streaming its signal should clearly indicate the filing is not intended to waive any exemptions from liability the stations may have under the law.

NAB plans to file a request to extend the October 15 deadline, however a ruling on that request will not be made until after the deadline has passed.

Attached is a sample form you may wish to consider using in your October 15 filing with the Copyright Office. Initial Notices should be sent to Library of Congress, Copyright Office, Licensing Division, 101 Independence Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20557-6400 and should be accompanied by a \$20 filing fee. Checks should be made out to 'Register of Copyrights.'

The conditions on the statutory license are complicated. Moreover, if you use the statutory license, you may be obligated to pay, retroactively, for your streaming activities at a fee level not to be determined until next year in arbitration proceedings, and you may be subject to significant record keeping requirements. Accordingly, you should consult with your individual counsel before submitting the filing.
