For example I would not be able to add a supercharger to my vehicle, even though it has been specifically designed for one to be added after-market, nor would I be able to add the SkyzNet dashboard, which has internet and multi function wireless and mappings, voice mail, and am/fm digital radio in one unit, I would also not be able to replace the as shipped dashboard with something I would prefer that I might be able to read better due to impaired vision.
