For clarification, the exemption should not be limited to bias. It is my intention for the petition to encompass AI trustworthiness research, including research on bias, discrimination, copyright infringement, synthetic content, sexual imagery, and other non-security harms, as explained and elaborated in the Hacking Policy Council and OpenPolicy comments on the record.

As the Copyright Office form for a petition for a new exemption specifically states, a petitioner need not fully define the contours of the exemption. Other parties can further define and expound upon the petition during later phases of the proceeding, as was the case with the comments from the Hacking Policy Council and OpenPolicy.
