What Can I Do on the Copyright Office Website?

- ▷ Register your basic claim to copyright
- ▷ View and download Copyright Office publications
- ▷ Search online records of registrations and document recordings from 1978 forward

To make the Copyright Office website work for you, click on the following items:

- ▷ *Electronic Copyright Office* to register a basic copyright online. When you file your application online, you pay a lower fee, and your application will be processed more quickly than if you file using a paper application.
- ▷ *Current Fees* to find out about the charges for Copyright Office services
- ▷ *Copyright Basics* to read, download, or print general information on copyright
- ▷ *Search Our Site* to search the Copyright Office website
- ▷ *Search Copyright Records* to search the Copyright Office's online records
- ▷ *Copyright Law* to read, download, or print the copyright law
- ▷ *Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)* to read questions and answers about copyright and the Copyright Office
- ▷ *Hot Topics* to find out what is going on in the Copyright Office

- ▷ *Publications* to access forms, publications, and historical documents relating to copyright
- ▷ *Contact Us* to email questions about copyright or to request specific forms and circulars. Or call the Forms and Publications Hotline at (202) 707-9100 and leave a recorded request for specific publications. The items you request will be mailed to you.
