The **Notice of Termination** must be served on the grantee and recorded with the Copyright Office *before* the **Date of Termination**.

† If the copyright in the work was secured on or after 10/27/1939, a grant involving that work cannot be terminated under Section 304(d).

‡ 10/26/2019 is the last possible date for terminating a grant under Section 304(d) involving a work originally registered or published with notice in 1939.

‡ 10/26/2017 is the last possible date for serving a Notice of Termination under Section 304(d) for a grant involving a work originally registered or published with notice in 1939.
