Dear Sirs:

We would like to file a short statement in support of the Copyright Office's proposal to discontinue the Form CO in registration practices.

We file registration applications related to the works of L. Ron Hubbard and have been using the online eRegistration for all application (with the exception of renewals). This is definitely a more efficient means of filing applications for the party filing them and the Copyright Office.

Pursuant to the Notice concerning the Form CO it is likely to cause errors and lengthen the examination process and thus needlessly tie up the Copyright Office when a more efficient system exists in the online eRegistration. That being the case, the Form CO should definitely be discontinued. By making the registration as efficient as possible and in every way possible will benefit all concerned.
