

## **Description of Copyright Deposits by Classification**

Old Class = New Class	<u>Description</u>
$A^* = TX$	Divided into A, Af, Afo, Aio; Published books, bibles, catalogs, charts, dictionaries, directories, encyclopedias, games, indexes- also some maps, microfilm, filmstrips, recordings, music jackets, journals, manuals, printouts, text books, law books, music poetry, puzzles, and multimedia. (Class A is the most numerous of all classes).
$B^* = TX$	Periodical; Dow-Jones teletype rolls, Standard & Poors Computer Cards. (Pornographic magazines are sent to Serial Records).
C = TX	Lectures
D = PA/PAu	Divided into Df, Dfo, Dp, Du, D ovs. (Previously D class) Dramatic work.
E = PA/PAu	Musical works, divided into Ep, Eu, Efo, Ef (Sheet music)
$F^* = VA$	Map; all maps to Geography and Map Division, with exception of some newer class maps.
G = VA	Divided into Gf, Gfo, Gp, Gu, Gp ovs. Gu ovs (previously G class)- Work of art or a model or design for a work of art; jewelry, china, cloth, statuary, wall plaques, floor covering, plastic flowers, prints, sweaters, toys, photographs, and small trash receptacles.
$H^* = VA$	Reproduction of a work of art, similar to Gp and Gu, but not as numerous or varied; jewelry, china, cloth, statuary, wall plaques, floor covering, plastic flowers, prints, sweaters, toys, photographs, and small trash receptacles.
I = VA	Divided into IP and IU (previously I class); Drawing or plastic work of a scientific or technical character; blue prints, sketches.
J = VA	Divided into Jf, Jfo, Jp, and Ju (previously J class) Photographs; negatives, film strips.
$K^* = VA$	Prints or pictorial illustration used as commercial products; Divided into Kf, Kfo, and K.
KK = VA	Divided into KKf, KKfo, and KK; print or label used for article of merchandise; jewelry, china, cloth, statuary, wall plaques, floor covering, plastic flowers, prints, sweaters, toys, photographs, and small trash receptacles.

L = PA/PAu Divided into Lp and Lu (previously L class) Photoplays: i.e. TV programs on

magnetic tape. Detailed sheets, some film, some reels.

M = PA/PAu Divided into Mf, Mfo, Mp, and Mu (previously M class) Motion picture.

 $N^* = SR$  Sound Records: 331/3, 45, 78 recordings, and cassettes, and 8 track tape.

Sometimes becoming multimedia deposits involving A, K, KK, and Jp classes.

R = RE Renewal

Redfile Rejected items- held in abeyance and possible registered at a later time.

Multiple registration number deposits

TXu New class for unpublished books, periodicals, and lectures

PA Performing Arts, replaced Classes D, Ep, Ef, Efo, Lp, Lf, Lfo, Mp, Mf, Mfo

PAu Performing Arts unpublished, replaced Classes Du, Eu, Lu, and Mu

VA Visual Arts, replaced Classes Gp, Gf, Gfo, H, Hf, Hfo, Ip, If, Ifo, Jp, Jf, Jfo, K, Kf,

Kfo, KK, KKf, and KKfo

VAu Visual Arts unpublished, replaced Classes Gu, Iu, and Ju

SR Sound recordings, replaced Class N

SRu Sound recordings unpublished, new class for unpublished Sound Recordings

RE Renewals, replaced Class R
