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Standard Application - Registration Process Overview

The Standard Application may be used to register most works, including an original work, a derivative work, a collective work, or a compilation.

If the Copyright Office determines that your work cannot be registered with the Standard Application, your claim may be refused, or there may be delays in the examination of your claim that could require the payment of an additional fee and a later effective date of registration for your claim.

Exceptions

The Standard Application may be used to register 1 work (including 1 collective work or 1 derivative work). To register the following types of works, please return to the "Home" screen and use one of the "Other Registration Options" listed on that screen.

- 2 or more unpublished works: Return to the "Home" screen and select "Register a Group of Unpublished Works"
- . 2 or more photographs: Return to the "Home" screen and select "Register a Group of Photographs"
- 2 or more issues of a serial, newspaper, newsletter, or 2 or more contributions that were published in a periodical: Return to the "Home" screen and select "Register Certain Groups of Published Works"

Likewise, this application may not be used to register the works listed below. To register these types of works, you must complete a paper application.

- A registration for a group of updates to a non-photographic database
- A renewal registration
- Foreign works that have been restored to copyright protection
- · Mask works and vessel designs

This application may not be used to correct an error in an existing registration, or to amplify the information given in an existing registration. For this type of request, please return to the "Home" screen and select the option for "Correct or Amplify an Existing Registration".

To Complete the Application for Registration you must:

- 1) Provide all required information on the application form
- 2) Pay the required fee
- 3) Upload or mail-in a copy of your work

If your work is eligible for the Standard Application, click the "Start Registration" button.

Select "Sound Recording" if you are registering an audio recording. You may also select this option if you are registering both a recording, and the song, instrumental composition, literary work, or dramatic work contained in that recording.

A "musical work" (such as a song) and a particular recording of that song are two separate works. A musical work consists of the music and/or lyrics (either in printed or audio form). A recording of a particular performance of a song is a "sound recording."

A sound recording typically contains performance and/or production authorship.

A sound recording may be fixed within a CD, vinyl, cassette, audio tape, digital audio file (way, mp3, etc.), or the like. A recording fixed in a midi file, audiovisual work, video, or motion picture soundtrack is NOT considered a sound recording. If you are ONLY registering a musical work (such as music and/or lyrics) and if you are NOT registering the recorded performance of that work, select "Work of the Performing Arts" (regardless of whether the work is fixed in printed or audio form).

If you are ONLY registering a textual work (such as lecture, sermon, or book) and if you are NOT registering the recorded performance of that work, select "Literary Work" (regardless of whether the work is fixed in printed or audio form).

If you are ONLY registering a "sound recording" (such as the performance and/or production authorship contained within a particular recording) select "Sound Recording".

If you are registering BOTH a musical work and the recorded performance of that work, select "Sound Recording". Likewise, select "Sound Recording" if you are registering BOTH a textual work and the recorded performance of that work.

Note: A musical work (such as music and/or lyrics) or a textual work (such as a lecture, sermon, or book) and the recorded performance of that work may be registered with one application ONLY (i) if the author(s) named in the application contributed to both works, or (ii) if the copyright claimant owns all rights in both works through a written transfer of copyright.

For more information about registering sound recordings, see <u>Circular 58</u>. For more information about registering a sound recording and a musical work, or a sound recording and a textual work, see <u>Circular 58a</u>.

Important Note: You selected the "Standard Application." This application may be used to register 1 work (including 1 collective work or 1 derivative work).



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
TITLES - "PREVIOUS OR ALTERNATIVE TITLE"





TITLES - "TITLE OF LARGER WORK"






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TITLES - "SERIES TITLE"


