The Board of Appeals has received a second appeal dated August 19, 1998, relating to four Gianni Versace designs. The Copyright Office has instituted a charge for appeals which was effective on July 1, 1998. The Office published a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking identifying proposed new fees in the <u>Federal Register</u> on April 1, 1998. <u>See</u> 63 FR 15802. Final fees were also published on May 28, 1998. <u>See</u> 63 FR 29137 which is attached. I am enclosing SL-4 which further describes the new fees.
